The Berea City Club, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization established in 1998 by Mayor Stan Trupo as an organization to promote positive civic interests to the community of Berea. Through the efforts of The Berea City Club, Inc. and the support of the community, we have donated more than \$1,100,000 back to various clubs, organizations, and projects in the City of Berea.

The Berea City Club works year-round on events to raise money for projects that benefit many organizations and citizens in the City. Annually, The Berea City Club sponsors the Berea's National Rib Cook-off and Beer Fest on Memorial Day Weekend at the Cuyahoga County Fairgrounds, a clambake, the holiday trees along Coe Lake and Downtown Berea, and a community golf outing. The Berea City Club purchased new scoreboards and new athletic record boards at Berea-Midpark High School, donated the bleachers and press box for the Lou Groza Football League, and helped fund the weight room at the Roehm Athletic Complex.

In addition, we have made donations to improve and build the Coe Lake Nature Trail, build the Berea Clock Tower and Heritage Park, and rebuild the Arch at the Cuyahoga County Fairgrounds. Most recently, The Berea City Club funded the purchase and training of a new K-9 police dog, purchased three thermal imaging cameras for the Berea Fire Department, contributed to the purchase of a new Senior Connection Bus, and made a major donation to "The Berea City Club Mayor Stanley J. Trupo Makerspace" at Berea-Midpark High School.
